Required Testing: ATI TEAS

- Minimum Score: TEAS Composite score of 66% or higher.
- Retakes: The TEAS test can be retaken twice within a 12-month period, with a 14-day waiting period between attempts.
- TEAS scores are valid for two years.
 - 1. The ATI TEAS, or Test of Essential Academic Skills, is a standardized test designed specifically to assess a student's preparedness for entering the health science fields. Questions are designed to test the basic academic skills you will need to perform successfully in the areas of: Reading, Math, Science, and English and Language Usage.
