Main Installation Gallery (Lower Level)

\$500,000

- The McDonough's primary gallery
- Two stories high
- Largest space in the Museum
- Most adaptable/multi-functional space in the Museum
- Dramatic entrance featuring prominent access from the Grand Staircase
- Overview from balcony



Gallery A (Mid-level)

\$350,000

- Prominent access from the McDonough's Campus Commons entrance, which opens onto Gallery A
- Prominent access from the McDonough's Wick Avenue entrance
- Bright space due to Gallery A's proximity to the open ceiling of the Main Installation Gallery and the natural light exposure from Campus Commons Entrance
- Adjacency to the Balcony



Gallery B (Mid-level)

\$250,000

- Elegant, bright gallery
- Desirable proximity to the descending Spiral Staircase and Oculus Skylight
- Adjacency to the Balcony



Auditorium (Upper Level)

\$500,000

- Seats 50 in tiered theater-style seating
- Offers large-screen technology for audio-visual display
- Multi-purpose resource utilized for classroom instruction, visiting lecturers, art exhibitions and film entertainment
- Accessible from the McDonough's two primary entrances Campus Commons and Wick Avenue



Raw Space Gallery (Lower Level)

\$150,000

- Dramatic entrance featuring prominent access from the Grand Staircase
- Captures visitors from the Main Installation Gallery
- Designed for dynamic exhibitions; contemplative and slightly darker space is suitable for multi-media projects



The Grand Staircase (Mid and Lower Levels)

- \$100,000
- Prominent access from the McDonough's Campus Commons entrance
- Wide staircase that leads the visitor to the Main Installation and Raw Space Galleries
- Features dramatic overlook of Main Installation Gallery
- Prominent visibility from Campus Commons entrance, Main Installation Gallery, Gallery B and Balcony



The McDonough Campus Commons (Mid-Level/Outdoors)


\$100,000

- Picturesque gateway to the McDonough Museum from the Smoky Hollow side
- Features patio and landscaped spaces leading to the architecturally dramatic Museum entrance
- Offers a unique, contained environment that includes access to Bliss Hall, home of the College of Creative Arts and Communication



The Open Office Suite and Conference Room (Upper Level) \$250,000

- Direct access from Wick Avenue entrance
- Home to the hard-working museum staff
- Adjacent to the Office Suite



The Sculpture Patio (Street-Level/Outdoors)

\$75,000

- Outdoor Sculpture Patio to the right of McDonough Avenue street entrance
- High visibility on Wick Avenue
- Multiple-use space for exhibitions, receptions and Museum promotions
- Easy, open access to all viewers and guests



The Spiral Staircase (Lower and Mid Levels)

\$50,000

- Spiral staircase ascending from the Raw Space Gallery on Lower Level to Gallery B on Mid-Level
- Includes an oculus skylight at the top of the stairs
- Prominent architectural feature of the Museum
- Signature design of Gwathmey and Siegel
